PRIESTS FOR LIFE

Dear Parishioners:

The White House handed people of faith two victories this week and I hope you will join me in celebrating them!

Since 2012, Priests for Life has been battling the unjust mandate from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) that tried to force practically all employers (except houses of worship and some others), to provide abortifacient and contraceptive drugs and devices to their employees. We filed the fourth of what turned into more than 100 lawsuits, and ours, *Priests for Life vs. HHS*, was one of seven that was heard by the U.S. Supreme Court. The Court saw a way for the government and the petitioners to work out a solution, and ordered that they do so.

On Friday, the Administration put new rules in effect that broaden the exemption that houses of worship received to include faith-based ministries, like Priests for Life, and others as well, who have a religious or moral objection. This is a win for people of faith and all Americans.

On Tuesday, the House of Representatives passed by a strong margin the *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act,* saying that babies in the womb who can feel pain may not be aborted! This is a major victory. We now have to pressure the US Senate to pass this bill also, and we'll do so through our action alerts. **Please have your parishioners sign up for them at:**
