PARISH ELECTION NOTICE

On the weekend of May 20th and 21st we will hold elections for **Parish Council** & **Education Commission**. Any parish member who is over the age of 18 is eligible to run for either position. Both councils meet once a month and the terms of office are 3 years.

The Parish Council assists Father David in identifying, understanding, and implementing important matters that affect the life of the Parish. Committees springing from this include Liturgy, Buildings and Grounds and Activities/Social. With the pastor's approval, the council (along with many other parish volunteers) follows up and "takes care of the details" - enabling the priest to focus on pastoral matters.

The Education Commission is an advisory body which, holding no restrictions against race or national origin, operates the various educational programs of All Saints Catholic Parish. This encompasses the Religious Education Program and the Catholic school, and is subject to regulations of the Diocese of Madison. The purpose of the commission is to further the teaching mission of the Catholic Church by promoting various forms of Christian education that will best serve the needs of our community.

After the choice of ABORTION

Both Women and Men who have suffered through this traumatic experience need a process of healing and the best place to find this healing is through the grace of God. Healing through sacramental confession and absolution is absolutely essential to begin the healing process, but it may not fulfill the total emotional, spiritual, and moral needs of someone who has undergone a traumatic experience, such as abortion. Rachel's Vineyard was created just for this purpose. Theresa Burke and her husband, both of whom are Catholic therapists, started Rachel's Vineyard in our Madison Diocese. It has two aspects, the weekend retreat and a support group designed to meet men and women wherever they are at, who often have closed off some part of their emotionallyspiritual life because of what they have suffered. The retreat is holistic, sacramentallyminded, and aims at helping participants to open up to find the truth of whom God has made them to be, while working through what they have experienced and suffered. Participants on the retreat leave with a new sense of God, of His Church, and of themselves. They are at a better place to begin choosing to know, love and serve God. Similarly, even after a Rachel's Vineyard retreat there may be a need for ongoing spiritual-pastoral care and guidance or

professional counseling.

REGISTRATION FOR THE 2018-19 school year is open.

In past years, we have opened registration for the next school year in late spring. However, early registration is critical to our budgeting process, essential for determining the amount of staffing needed for the upcoming year, and necessary for predicting other operational expenses.

Enrollment for the 2018-19 school year is now open. All current families will receive a notification from TADS. New families can visit http://school.allsaintsberlin.org/, click on the TADS Admissions/Enrollment button, and create a new account.

Early Registration Credit – Our tuition increase for 2018-19 is \$100 per student to cover increases in health care and other school related costs. However, to promote early registration by March 23, 2018, the Education Commission and the Finance Council have approved a \$100 per student Early Registration Credit. For parents completing the registration process and making the appropriate deposit of \$100 per child by March 23, 2018, this early registration credit will offset the tuition increase for next year. The registration deposit of \$100 per child applies toward your tuition and is non-refundable.
