+ Confirmation Defined (CCC. 1285, page 325)

Baptism, the EUCHARIST, and the sacrament of Confirmation TOGETHER constitute the "sacraments of Christian Initiation," whose UNITY must be safe-guarded. It must be explained to the faithful that the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the COMPLETION of baptismal grace. *For "by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the HOLY SPIRIT. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, MORE STRICTLY OBLIGED TO SPREAD AND DEFEND THE FAITH BY WORD AND DEED."*
