

THE SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER: DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The Feast of Divine Mercy comes to us through a humble Polish nun, St. Faustina. Our Lord's desires regarding Divine Mercy are recorded in her Diary. Jesus told St. Faustina that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when **"all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet.... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy".** (Diary 699) Our Lord made a great promise to all those souls who would go to Confession & then receive Him in Holy Communion on the Feast of His Mercy, now called Divine Mercy Sunday throughout the Catholic Church.
