***EXCITING CHANGES AT ASCS FOR 2018-2019 SCHOOL CLASSROOM REFURBISH PROJECT***

**Q: WHY A CLASSROOM REFURBISH PROJECT?**

A: In an effort to better meet the physical and educational needs of our students, ASCS will be making changes to our school building this summer. All Grades will be moving to different classrooms. Kindergarten-Grade 4 will move to the East wing of the building where there are larger classrooms, wider hallways, and larger bathrooms. This also places the younger students closer to the office. Older students in Grades 5-8 will move to a newly designed West wing with a Science Lab and flexible teaching environments that offer various opportunities for hands-on learning.

There will also be some upgraded lighting in the East wing hallway. Additionally, we have applied for a grant from the Diocese of Madison. If the grant is approved we will be able to install some much needed new windows in the West wing and a new security door near the main office.

**Q: WHEN WILL THIS HAPPEN?**

A: Our hope is that every classroom can be cleaned and freshly painted in June, beginning with the West wing and progressing through all classrooms.

**Q: WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED?**

A: There will be no structural changes. The intent is to clean, paint and change location of Grades in the classrooms.

**Q: HOW WILL WE PAY FOR THIS PROJECT?**

A: This will take time, effort and of course, some additional cost. We are reaching out to all parish members to help accomplish these needed changes for our parish school. Please consider the following:

**Teaching Our Children the Importance of Being Catholic**  
An interesting situation occurred at All Saints Catholic School after the snowfall on Wednesday, April 4. Because of the snow, there was a two-hour delay in the start of classes. While one would expect students to celebrate the delay with fewer classes and more sleep (I know as a child, I would have!) Much to my surprise, most students at ASCS came to school disappointed. Why were they disappointed? Because the delay meant cancelling Wednesday's 9:15 all-school Mass. Students were heard saying, "I want to go to Mass today." "Why does Mass have to be cancelled?" "Shouldn't we have a prayer service or something?" To ease the situation, staff members had to speak with students and during prayer and announcements over the speaker system, even the principal apologized that the students had to miss Mass.
