WORSHIP WITHOUT WORRY

Unfortunately, shootings in schools, churches, and other public places around the country are becoming much more common. Our parish feels it is prudent to be as prepared as possible for this kind of emergency. This is certainly no easy task. We want our church to be a welcoming place where people are free to enter, yet feel safe in their surroundings. How do we face the challenge of keeping the doors open to all, while simultaneously protecting those inside? To address this question and come up with a plan of action, our parish recently formed a Safety Committee.

The Safety Committee is comprised of parishioners who are already involved with various activities and ministries in our parish, and most of them have background in law enforcement. The Safety Committee's purpose is to establish an Emergency Action Plan (EAP). The committee will meet with local law enforcement, consider guidelines recommended by the diocese, and study plans already in use by other churches to help formulate a plan that makes sense for All Saints Catholic Church.

The committee will work to have an EAP that will set forth procedures to be followed in the event of an active shooter or other emergencies such as dangerous weather, fire, bomb threat, etc. The goal, of course, is to keep the people in and around the building as safe from harm as possible.
