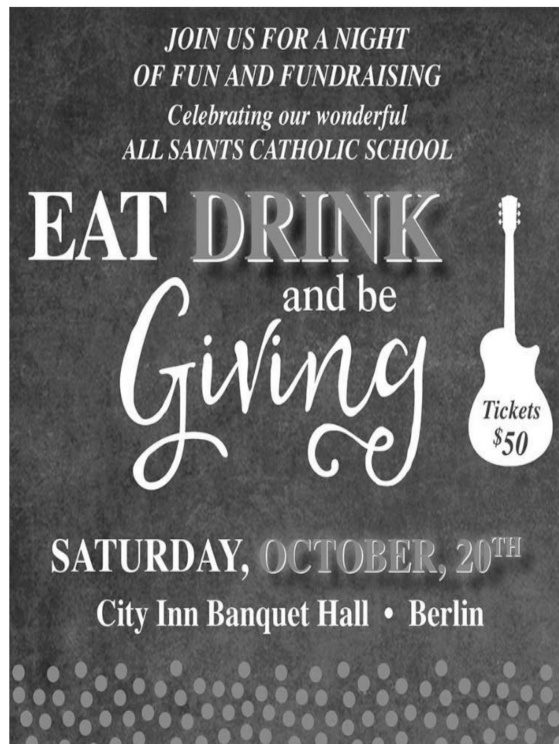
**HARVEST DINNER THIS SUNDAY, OCT. 14**
