**MORE INFORMATION REGARDING
IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER**

FEDERAL INCOME TAX - The donor's taxable income is reduced by the amount of the IRA Charitable Rollover but the donor may not claim a charitable deduction for the same amount

STATE OF WI INCOME TAX - The donor must add the amount of the IRA Charitable Rollover to their taxable income but may claim a charitable deduction for the same amount.

DONOR SHOULD CONSULT TAX ADVISOR OR FINANCIAL CONSULTANT FOR ACCURATE PLANNING AND PREPARATION OF INCOME TAX RETURNS.

40 DAYS FOR LIFE!

So many times we have been asked to pray for an end to abortions but never was there a more acceptable time than on the chilly, wet, and windy day of November 4, when a group of "prayer warriors" took a bus to Madison. In conjunction with the "40 Days for Life" celebration held in Madison and many locations across the United States, they walked the sidewalk and prayed the rosary for 1 and ½ hours. Parishioners from All Saints and Our Lady of the Lake boarded a bus sponsored by our Holy Name Society (we even had one good Lutheran join us) to participate in this event which has inspired 750,000 volunteers praying around the clock for 40 days! There have been 2 such "campaigns" and the proven results have been:

*14, 643 babies saved from abortion

*177 abortion workers converted

*96 abortion centers closed

Our group received the following note from one of the team leaders of this event:

*I cannot thank you enough for the wonderful presence All Saints (Berlin) and Our Lady of the Lake (Green Lake) provided on Sunday. What a wonderful example of prayer, perseverance and faith your communities displayed. Surely, God is pleased and will bless all of you richly for your witness to life here in Madison and continued good work up in the Oshkosh area. In gratitude, I will offer a Mass for all of your participants and their intentions. Please keep us in your prayers, as well. After the elections, we may now have a more difficult fight in ending abortion here in Wisconsin but our faith affirms that God will win over evil. In the meantime, we can continue to witness and pray to change hearts, helping one soul at a time. Our prayers and work are pleasing to him. I hope everyone warmed up over a nice meal and your travel home was uneventful and safe.
