As you know, Bishop Robert Morlino, 4th bishop of Madison, passed away on November 24th. The following lists all the arrangements pertaining to his funeral and burial.

- a. **Prayer Vigil/Solemn Vespers** - A Prayer Vigil, with opportunity for visitation, will be held Monday, December 3rd, at the O'Donnell Chapel at Holy Name Heights, 702 S. High Point Rd., Madison, from 1:00-7:00 PM, with Solemn Vespers beginning at 7:00 PM, Bishop Paul Swain presiding.
- b. **Visitation** - Visitation on Tuesday, December 4th, at St. Maria Goretti Catholic Church, Madison, from 9:00 AM until just prior to the Funeral Mass.
- c. **The Mass of Christian Burial (Funeral Mass)** - Celebrated at St. Maria Goretti Catholic Church, 5313 Flad Ave., Madison, at 11:00 AM. The Most Reverend Jerome Listeki, Archbishop of Milwaukee, will be the principal celebrant and Monsignor James R. Bartylla, will be the homilist.
- d. **Interment** - Interment will be at Resurrection Cemetery immediately following the Funeral Mass.
