As these subcommittees move forward, it's possible you may be contacted to share your particular knowledge or skill in one of these areas. If so, I hope you will be able to help. Please pray that these efforts will result in constructive decisions and actions to lead our parish school into the future as we continue to Build Saints, Scholars and Children of God.
