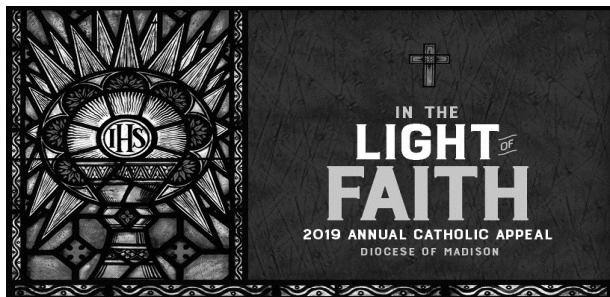
2019 DIOCESE OF MADISON ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL BEGINS
