#### LENTEN REGULATIONS

This coming Wednesday, March 6, marks the beginning of Lent. With this changing of liturgical seasons comes again a quieter time to focus on God. Part of this practice includes fasting. Please review the following rules and guidelines for fasting and abstinence during Lent.

## **Fasting**

Fasting is the act of doing with less. In the Catholic Church, those ages 18 - 59 must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Liquids are allowed at any time, but no solid food should be consumed between meals.

## **Abstinence**

Abstinence is the act of doing without. Catholics age 14 and over are expected to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays throughout the Lenten Season.
