## Parish Election Notice

On the weekend of May 18th and 19th we will hold elections for Parish Council, Education Commission and Trustee. To be in conformance with the Diocese standard bylaws, starting this year and each year after, the following changes have been made to the Election procedure: (changes shown in **BOLD**)

### PARISH COUNCIL

The total membership of the Council shall be (9). Each year, three (3) members of the Council shall be elected for a term of three (3) years. Each year, one member of those vacancies (may) be appointed by the Pastor for a term of three (3) years. Members may serve for no more than two (2) consecutive terms.

A vacancy on the Council may be appointed by the Pastor. If the Pastor declines to appoint a member, the vacancy shall be filled by the person who in the current election received the next highest number of votes.

A youth representative, of high school age, and active in the Parish, may be appointed by the Pastor for a term of one (1) school year, to the Council, having the same function and privileges as adult members.

### EDUCATION COMMISSION

Each year, three (3) members of the Council shall be elected for a term of three(3) years. Each year, one (1) member of those vacancies (may) be appointed by the Pastor for a term of three (3) years. Members may serve for no more than two (2) consecutive terms.

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The Parish Council meets once a month and assists the pastor in identifying, understanding, and implementing important matters that affect the life of the parish. Committees that stem from this include Liturgy, Building/Grounds and Social activities. With pastor's approval, they help take care of the details enabling the pastor to focus on pastoral matters.

The Education Commission meets once a month and is an advisory body which operates the various educational programs of All Saints Catholic Parish. This encompasses the Religious Education Program and the Catholic School, and is subject to the regulations of the Diocese of Madison. The purpose of the commission is to further the teaching mission of the Catholic Church by promoting various forms of Christian education that will serve the needs of our community.

Any parish member who is over the age of 18 is eligible to run for Parish Council, Education Commission, or Trustee. If you would like to submit your name to be placed on the ballot, contact the parish office for an application form.

Any youth of high school age, and active in the parish, who wish to be considered for the youth representative appointed by the Pastor, should reach out to Fr. David at the parish office and provide a brief explanation to why he/she feels they should be considered for the one (1) school year term to serve on the Parish Council. **SANCTUARY LAMP** - lit to signal the True Presence of Christ in the tabernacle is donated in memory of Bob Blazel by the John Blazel and Mary Kay Blazel Families.
