

Last year, Offertory collections from July 2017-April 2018 were \$638,987.11. This year, Offertory collections from July 2018-April 2019 are \$591,361.10. <u>-\$47,626.01</u>

Since monthly income does not meet the cost of routine operation of our parish and school, we are taking the following steps to do what we can to help.

- Over all office hours will be reduced. The parish office will be closed on Mondays, but remain open from 8 4 Tuesday through Friday.
- Staffing hours will be reduced accordingly.
- Housekeeping for the rectory will be cut in half.
- All the parking lot lights have been changed to LED which significantly reduces the use of electricity. During the dark evenings of winter, they provide security up here on the hill. During the long days of summer they will be turned off earlier.
- All lights within the church proper and gathering space have been changed over to LED.
- Professional lawn treatment of church grounds will be reduced.
- Two phones line will be eliminated (we are charged for each line). Please be patient if you get a busy signal, as the lines are in use.
- The annual professional outdoor cleaning of the many glass windows is cancelled.
- HVAC (heat and air conditioning) in the offices, meeting rooms and church nave will be moderately adjusted. Please dress accordingly.
- When trying to reduce costs, expenditure on Religious Education, our Catholic School and parish youth programs are the very last to be touched. They are the future of the Church!
- These are always difficult decisions to make. Since our call from the Lord is to grow, we are faced with the challenge of "Can we reduce costs without reducing/lessening/weakening our ministries?" We look to God to provide.
