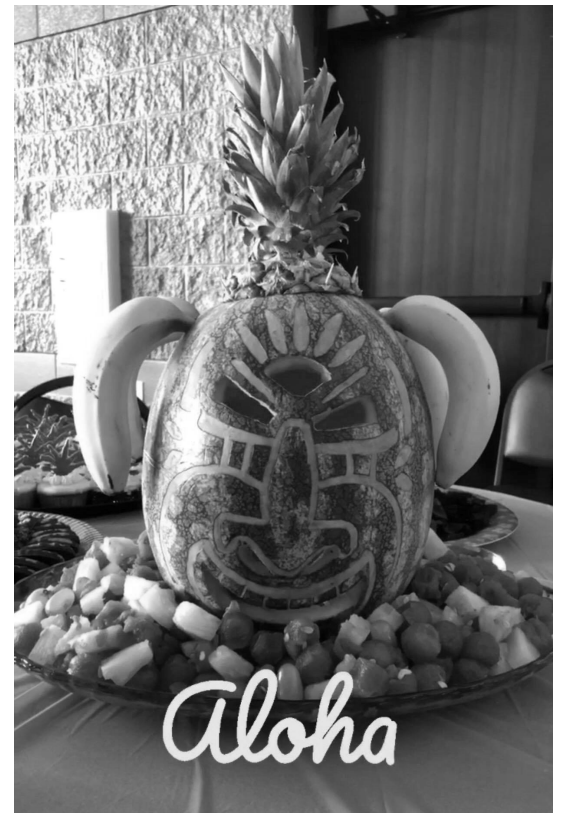
## **ALL SAINTS CATHOLIC SCHOOL REGISTRATION NOW OPEN!**

### Baptism

### Communion to the Homebound
