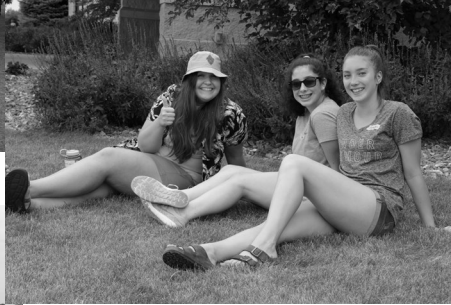

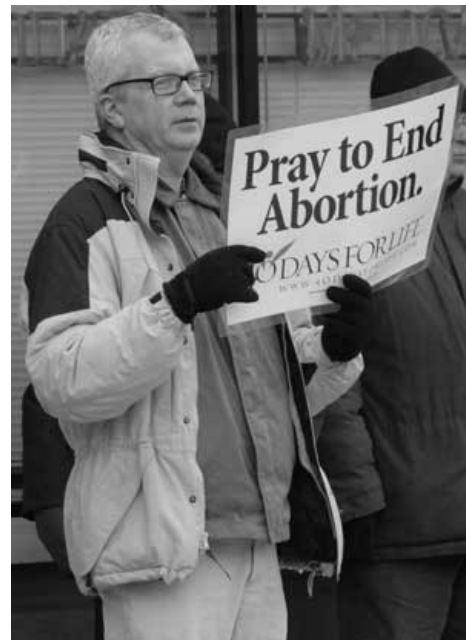

## Public Prayer to End Abortion

Our new bishop has a long history of publicly defending the rights of the unborn and speaking out against the evil of abortion. He has gone to abortion sites where he held signs and prayed as a peaceful and public witness that the Church supports the sanctity of all life, from conception until natural death. There is a picture of Bishop Hying holding a sign that says, "Abortion Kills Children" and brief article in the July 11 edition of the Catholic Herald in the special "Welcome, Bishop Hying" section. In part, the article states: "For many years I have prayed near abortion sites, trying to be a presence of love, faith and support to the women and men who find themselves in a desperate situation of crisis pregnancy and think abortion is the only way out. In all kinds of weather, in every season and every hour, witnesses to the sacred gift of life stand as sentinels of the Dawn on High at these clinical places of death."



All Saints Parish has a faithful group of people who meet outside Planned Parenthood in Oshkosh to pray to end to abortion. They meet at 5:30 pm on the first Monday of the month on the frontage road near the Planned Parenthood facility. If peaceful and public witness is something you feel called to do, please join them if you are able to do so. Their next gathering will be on Monday, August 5th.

### Baptism

At All Saints Parish, Baptisms are usually celebrated on Sundays after the 10 am Mass.

Arrangements must be made 6 months in advance. Marriage Preparation courses are required.

### Blessed Sacrament Adoration

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on the Thursday before the First Friday 2:30-6:30 PM

### Communion to the Homebound

All Saints Parish feels that it is important the sick, elderly, and homebound of our parish still receive the Holy Eucharist. If you or someone you know is ill or is unable to attend Mass and would like to receive the Eucharist outside of Mass, please contact the parish office.
