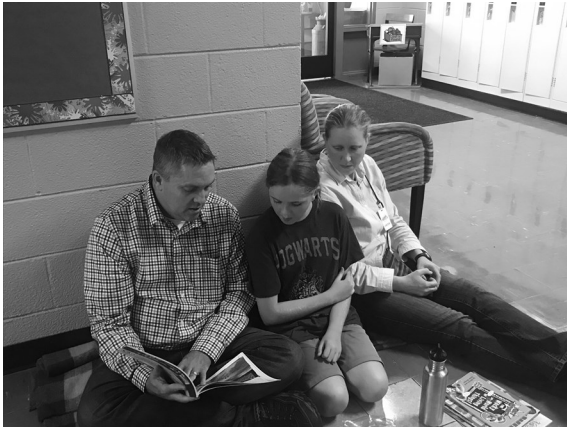

Dean and Trevor read a book about Manners to the whole school on Wednesday Morning.



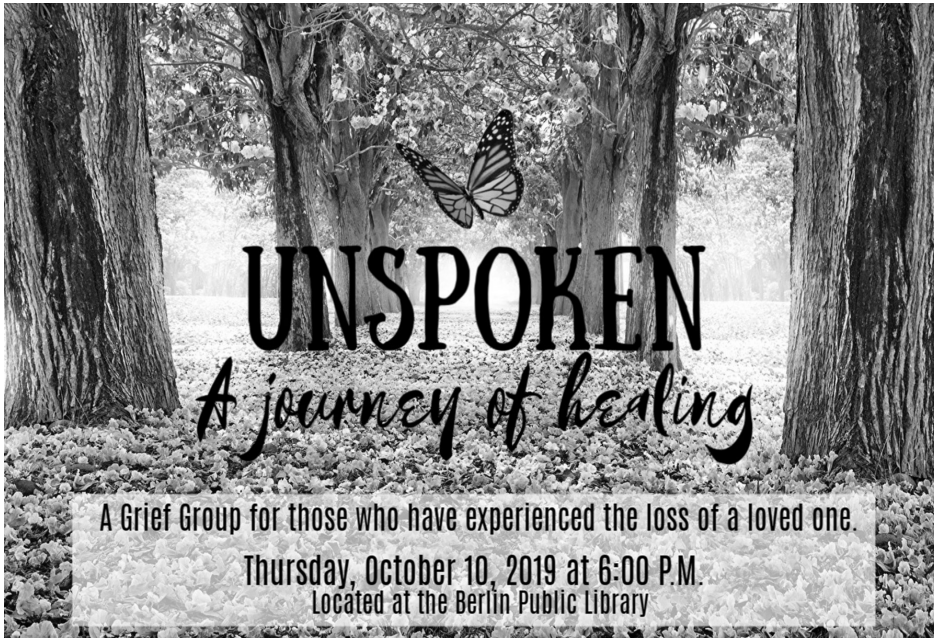

Important Message from Father David:

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ~

I felt it was very important to pass along some information about a text scam that began this Tuesday. I urge you to take careful consideration before you act upon any request that you may receive from a text or a gmail account from me. Should you receive a text or email using my name in which your pastor is asking for money, "I need a Favor" or "I need a gift card of any kind" - you should confirm this request first with us at the parish office. This same scam has been an acute problem throughout the Diocese and surrounding areas which have affected many priests. Providing you with this information about this type of scam - "to be forewarned is to be forearmed".

In any situation, whether it be a phone call, an email, or someone who comes to your door ask, I ask that you always act on the side of caution and get the information of the person calling you, their phone number so that you can return their call after asking a few questions first. Call the parish office before you agree to send money or share your private information; such as social security numbers or credit card numbers over the phone to others you do not know, through any means of communication, email or social media.

MASS BOOK NOW OPEN FOR 2020 - You are welcome to schedule Masses or sanctuary lamp for 2020. In an effort to provide equity and give all parishioners an opportunity to schedule Mass intentions, we ask that people follow these general guidelines: Each person can schedule one Mass intention per year, and each family can schedule one Mass intention per year. (For example, a husband schedules a Mass, a wife schedules a Mass, and together as a family they schedule a Mass, for a total of 3 Masses for this 2-person family.) We also limit sanctuary lamps and weekend Masses to one per family per year. Mass stipends are \$10 and the Sanctuary lamp is \$5. Thank you.
