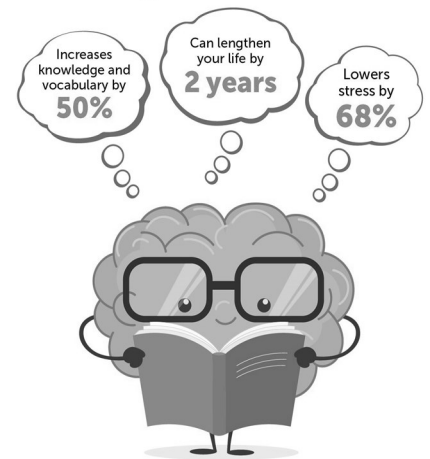

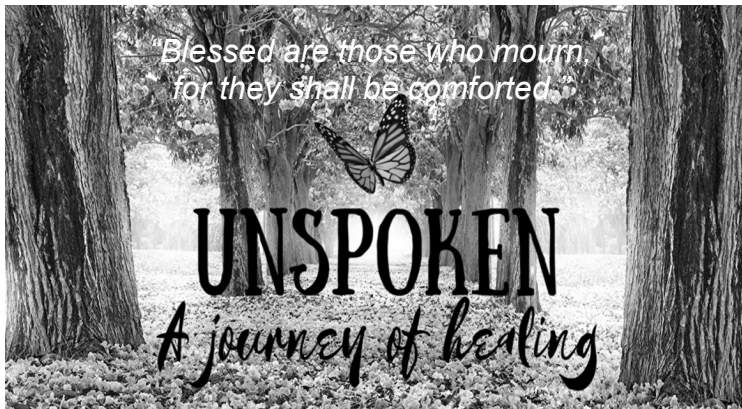
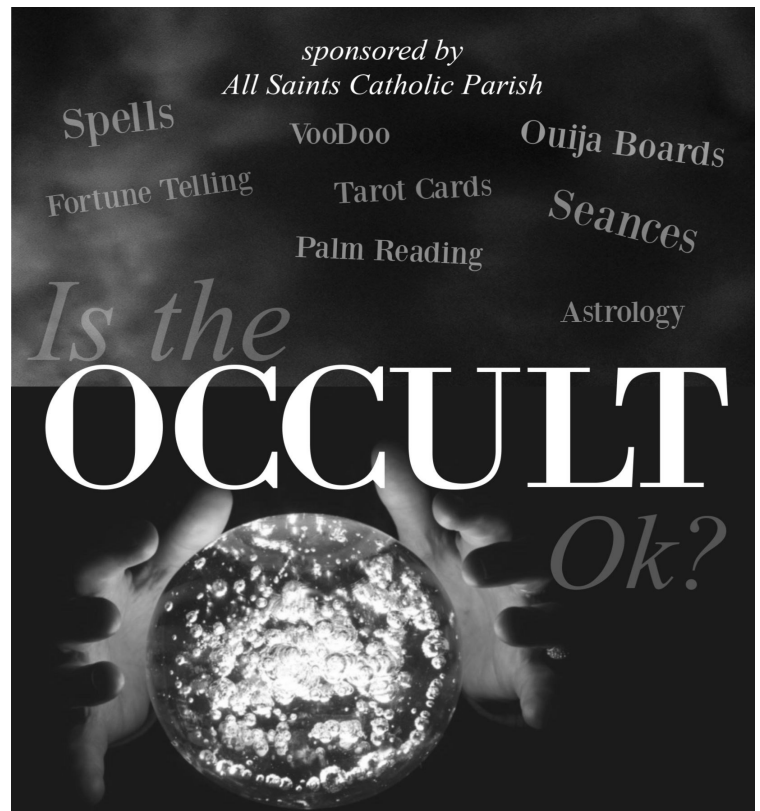
## Is the Occult OK?
