
Is the Occult OK?

VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Catechist: "These words I am commanding you today are to be upon your hearts. And you shall teach them diligently to your children and speak of them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as reminders on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorposts of your houses and on your gates." (Deut 6:6-9). The Mission of a Catechist is such an important one. It is a mission that has been given to the whole Church: that every individual Christian shares in the work of Jesus Christ. The Role of a Catechist is to bring our young people closer to Jesus and grow in their faith as Catholics. Through their service the catechist nurtures and mentors the faith and spiritual growth of the children they teach so that they may form a firm commitment to follow Christ. Qualifications of a Catechist: A catechist must be at least 18 years old, a practicing Catholic in good standing who attends weekly Mass regularly, has a love for children, the desire to grow in faith and share that journey with young people, the ability to relate well to others, a sense of humor and flexibility, and a willingness to be of service to the Church.

<u>Adult Classroom Aides:</u> Volunteers are needed to assist in the classroom every week and possibly substitute for the teacher when needed.

Substitute Teachers: Volunteers are needed to fill in for teachers when absent.

<u>Teen Aides:</u> Volunteers who are in 8th grade through High School are needed to help out in the classroom every week.
