#### Buildings and Grounds update for All Saints Catholic School:

You may recall, in the January 20, 2019 bulletin, it was announced that members of the Parish Council, Education Commission and Finance Council met in November of 2018 to initiate a collaborative effort to analyze the operations of our Parish School and plan for both immediate and future needs. Four subcommittees were formed to work on Marketing/Enrollment, Fundraising, Technology and Building. The Building subcommittee was given the task of exploring various options for the future of the All Saints Catholic School. Lengthy discussion included such options as:

- 1. Building a new school building on the hill adjacent to the church
- 2. Building an entire new school on the existing site in town
- 3. Building on to the existing school at the existing site

Both option #2 and #3 would include the possibility of having to remove the oratory and erect a multi-purpose building adjacent to the existing school. This would serve as a gym, cafeteria, additional room for music class, fine arts, and a stage for school productions. The committee has asked for estimates and has sent a letter to the city asking if a variance would be needed.

Relying on monies that remain in the original building fund, we would be able to cover the cost of the third option. According to church **and** government law, those dollars in the building fund can only be used for "new building". It cannot be used in other areas or moved to the general parish fund. The monies remaining in the original building fund and any gain realized from investment of these funds has been segregated from other parish funds.

It is important to know that we are ONLY in the planning, talking and thinking stages. **Nothing** has been decided by the steering committee, the councils or Father. These committees were formed to help build our school community and continue our mission of having a Catholic School that is strong both academically and spiritually. We will try to keep you updated as things progress.

#### Safe Parish Initiative

The Diocese of Madison has launched a Safe Parish Initiative, which is a program meant to encourage Parishes (church, rectory, school and playgrounds) to take steps to protect their premises and those who use them. For those who do not know, Catholic Mutual Group, Our Insurance Carrier, offers insight and direction in matters of risk management on behalf of the Diocese of Madison. Like many of us, Catholic Mutual is concerned about the increase in violence at, or near churches, which has risen dramatically in recent years. The saying, "it could never happen here," no longer applies. To assist in that endeavor, Catholic Mutual has launched the Safe Parish Initiative to promote and raise awareness, and provide steps that can be taken to help make our parishes safer.

At the recommendation of the Diocese, Catholic Mutual, and careful consideration from our Finance Council and Safety Committee members, All Saints parish plans to move forward and install a security camera(s) and a 'key access card system'. Already, a few parishioners have made generous donations toward the funding of this project which, God willing, will be installed during the first few weeks of January 2020.

Those who have keys to access the church complex will need to contact the parish office **by January 1st, 2020** so we can update records of keys issued and have a new key access card ready for you when the system is installed. Father feels that at that time, it's prudent to review the rather extensive list of issued keys. That doesn't mean it will be changed, but it does need to be reviewed. Further communication will be sent out about how you can pick up the key fob and how it will work.

Thank you for your attention and support to this important topic; as we come to worship and "Grow in the Spirit" as a parish family, we want to do our best to provide safety in an ever changing world. The safety committee consisted of former and current police officers, detectives and emergency personnel. Father David is very grateful to the committee, and thanks them for their combined efforts and professional focus. Even efforts such as this are meant for the glory of Christ and the good of His Church.
