### Students Learn Spanish Traditions at ASCS

Dia de Los Reyes (the Epiphany) is a special tradition/celebration in Mexico. All the children wait for Los Reyes Magos (Three Wise Men) for they bring them gifts just like they did to baby Jesus. It is tradition that families get together and eat La Rosca de Reyes. La Rosca is a sweet bread shaped in a circle with 4 to 6 baby Jesus figurines baked inside. Just like Mary and Joseph hid Jesus from King Herod, we hide the baby in the bread. The cutting of the bread represents the danger the baby Jesus was in. The bread baked in a circle represents God's never ending Love. The people who get the baby figurine get to host a party on El Dia de La Candelaria (Candlemas) on Feb. 2nd. Our middle school students had the opportunity to participate and learn about this tradition in our Spanish Classes.

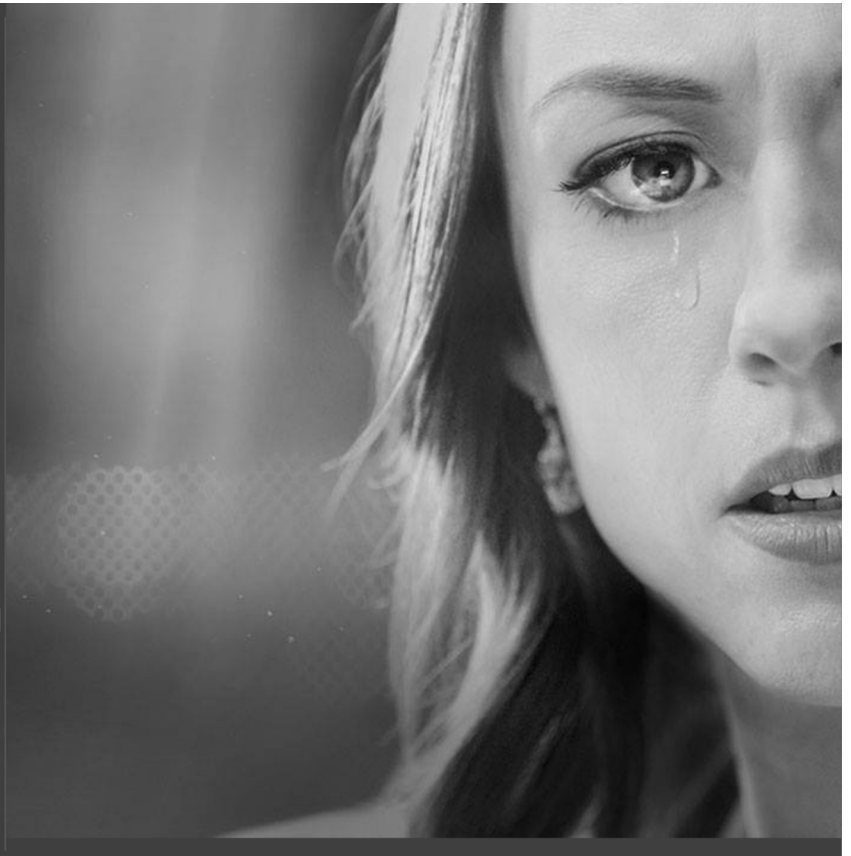
