**Follow the steps to download the All Saints App:**

**Text: ALLSAINTSAPP to 77977**

**When the link appears in the message—click on it. It will prompt you to GET the app. Once the app downloads, you will be able to click on the app and open it.**

**There will be a prompt to create your profile. Under the gear icon in the top right hand corner of the screen.**

**Be sure to select all the categories –*specifically Youth formation* so that you will get the updates and push notifications that will be sent out via the app.**

Since we cannot come together to celebrate Mass on the weekend, please consider praying the enclosed “Spiritual Communion” together as a family. There are also many places to watch Mass – both online and on TV. For example, EWTN has daily Mass and WISC-TV Channel3000 televises Mass on Sunday at 6:00 AM and TVW and Direct TV 14 on Sunday at 7:00 AM. There are also apps, such as the Relevant Radio app, that you can download for free that have livestreams as well as recorded Masses to watch, and other great Catholic resources as well.
