

With the "Stay Home Order" and Social Distancing guidelines in place, we knew that getting together to celebrate at this time would not be in the plan so with everyone's help, this was a creative alternative to help wish her well as a memorable send off she will surely never forget.

We are most grateful and blessed for what Cindy has helped All Saints Parish accomplish over the last 3.75 years. She has paved the way for how we will continue to conduct business in the future. We know that this is not good-bye for Cindy Schrader as we will see her at Mass in the near future. We know that All Saints Parish is and always will be a very big part of her and John's life. We wish her well in her retirement and she will be missed.



EVENTS

Church Office - Our office **will not** be open to the public, but will be minimally staffed Tuesday-Friday, from 8 AM - noon, to take phone calls and support parishioners. We will still be regularly checking emails and voicemail as well as updating our website and Facebook pages so we will stay in touch with all of you. Be safe, stay well.

Private Prayer Time - The church will remain open for private prayer. We ask that you use the hand sanitizer at the entrance and remember that there is a **limit of 9 people** in the church at a time. It is very important we abide by this rule. This also applies to confession times on Wednesday evenings from 4:30 - 6:30, and Eucharistic Adoration.

Eucharistic Adoration - Thursday, April 30 from 2:30-5:30 PM.

Parish Elections will be postponed until a later date when we are able to hold the public celebration of Mass and everyone has the opportunity to vote. The elected members whose term is up have agreed to graciously extend until we can hold elections. For now we would like parishioners to consider being part of the parish council or education commission.

- The Parish Council meets once a month and assists the pastor in identifying, understanding, and implementing important matters that affect the life of the parish. Committees that stem from this include Liturgy, Building/Grounds and Social activities. With pastor's approval, they help take care of the details enabling the pastor to focus on pastoral matters.
- The Education Commission meets once a month and is an advisory body which operates the various educational programs of All Saints Catholic Parish. This encompasses the Religious Education Program and the Catholic School, and is subject to the regulations of the Diocese of Madison. The purpose of the commission is to further the teaching mission of the Catholic Church by promoting various forms of Christian education that will serve the needs of our community.

Any parish member who is over the age of 18 is eligible to run for Parish Council, Education Commission, or Trustee. If you would like to submit your name to be placed on the ballot, contact the parish office for an application form. Any youth of high school age, and active in the parish, who wish to be considered for the youth representative appointed by the Pastor, should reach out to Fr. David at the parish office and provide a brief explanation to why he/she feels they should be considered for the one (1) school year term to serve on the Parish Council.


Confirmation Families & Confirmands

SCAM ALERT!

We feel it is important to pass along some information about a new scam that has recently taken place. We are still getting word that a number of emails are being sent to you, attributed to Bishop Hying and/or a priest of the Diocese of Madison, asking that the recipient "email me as soon as you get this message" or to "buy gift cards" for the bishop or a priest. This is not how the bishop or the priests/parishes will ever approach you for assistance. We urge you to take careful consideration before you act upon any request that you may receive through an email account from Bishop Hying, Fr. David, the parish office, or any office of the Diocese of Madison. Should you receive an email using any of these names in which you are asked for money or for gift cards, you should first confirm this request with us at the parish office.

Sadly, predators are using this current crisis to take advantage of good and generous people. The bishop is sending no such email and neither are our priests. Any official Church email will come from a legitimate (and likely easily validated) email address and only ever link to official websites. Scams such as this have been an acute problem throughout the Diocese.

Regardless of how the information is received, I encourage you to act on the side of caution. If something "doesn't seem right" call the parish office or the Diocese of Madison to verify if something is, indeed, legitimate. One should never hastily share private information such as social security numbers, credit card numbers, or banking information to those you do not know. Not over the phone other means of communication or social media.

"To be forewarned is to be forearmed"!
