### Diocese of Madison to Rollout Reopening Plan Early Next Week

MADISON — With the Wisconsin Supreme Court ruling of May 13th, which overturned Governor Evers' state-wide Emergency Order #28, i.e., the "Safer at Home" Order, Most Reverend Donald Hying, Bishop of Madison offered the following brief statement:

*"I certainly appreciate the exception added to the Public Health Madison and Dane County Order of May 13th, which while continuing to list religious entities as 'Essential Businesses and Operations', also allows for more reasonably-sized congregations for public worship while maintaining appropriate health-related safeguards, and I look forward to seeing this exception for religious entities being adopted in our other ten counties in the Diocese of Madison, and hopefully statewide in any possible future state order. In light of these recent developments, I am working closely with our Office of Worship and other diocesan leaders, and I will be in communication with the priests of the diocese, in order to create a careful plan recognizing both societal health concerns and the spiritual needs of the faithful. I anticipate the plan for public worship will be finalized next week with implementation as soon as reasonably possible while recognizing the possibility of further changes from the civil government. I take this opportunity to commend our civil leaders, public health professionals, and our health care workers for their hard work and courage during the pandemic. My prayers remain for those who are suffering and for a swift end to the pandemic. May God bless you."*

The Diocese of Madison is comprised of 11 counties in south-central Wisconsin, with rural and urban, large and small parishes throughout. In remaining in compliance with county and municipal orders, liturgies and worship will look different in nearly every one of our 134 churches.

# EVENTS

**Private Prayer Time** - The church will remain open for private prayer, Tues. - Thurs., 8 AM - 4 PM. We ask that you use the hand sanitizer at the entrance. Please remember that there is a **limit of 9 people** in the church at a time.

**Church Office** - Our office is not currently open to the public, but will be minimally staffed Tuesday-Friday, from 8 AM - noon, to take phone calls and support parishioners. We will still be regularly checking emails and voicemail as well as updating our website and Facebook pages so we will stay in touch with all of you. Be safe, stay well.

**Parish Elections** will be postponed until a later date when we are able to hold the public celebration of Mass and everyone has the opportunity to vote. The elected members whose term is up have agreed to graciously extend until we can hold elections. For now we would like parishioners to consider being part of the parish council or education commission. Any parish member who is over the age of 18 is eligible to run for Parish Council, Education Commission, or

Trustee. If you would like to submit your name to be placed on the ballot, contact the parish office for an application form. Any youth of high school age, and active in the parish, who wish to be considered for the youth representative appointed by the Pastor, should reach out to Fr. David at the parish office and provide a brief explanation to why he/she feels they should be considered for the one (1) school year term to serve on the Parish Council.

**Cemetery Clean-Up** - It's that time of the year again for some spring cleaning! If you've placed any flowers, Christmas decorations, etc. on gravesites over the winter, we ask that you come and remove these things in the next week or two so our sextons can start cutting the lawn. Thank you for your kind attention to this.

**Breaking Bread Missalettes** - We have extra missalettes that we are not using. If your family would like to have one for home use, we will have them on a table in the gathering of church. You are welcome to take one, free of charge. We hope this will aid in your at-home participation in the Holy Mass. One book per family, please.

**Memorial Day Mass** - Will be livestreamed from church on Monday, May 25 at 9:00 AM. You can join us on Facebook for the livestream or you can see the Mass as a replay on our website.

**Lawn Mowing Volunteers Needed** - Over the past 2 summers we have had a few individuals step down from the volunteer schedule, so we are looking for few good volunteers who would like to fill those places and serve the church by mowing the lawn. We have ride-on mowers, or if you prefer to bring your own mower you can do that too. Interested individuals can call or email the parish office to let us know your availability. Thank you!

**Update on Parish Festival and Chris Kroeze Concert** - Unfortunately, we are unable to hold these two events in June like we originally intended. Because this is such a great fundraiser and occasion for fellowship, the festival committee is looking into having the festival at a later date in the summer or fall. Chris Kroeze is unable to reschedule for a weekend later in the season, but we are working with him to come up with some alternate plans as well. We are hopeful and optimistic about these events and will keep you informed as we know any definite dates or other details.

## Calling all Students and Parents of Students Who Will Be Graduating From 8th or 12th Grade This Spring!

We realize we may not be able to hold our usual Graduation Mass for our graduates, but we would still very much like to acknowledge them and honor them. We are planning to have a slide show that could be shown after Mass on Sunday, June 7. If we are still livestreaming Mass on Sunday, June 7, we will play the slideshow immediately following the Mass on Facebook. Or if we are at church that weekend we will play the slideshow on the TV screen in the gathering area. After that, it would be available to view on our Facebook page and webpage, so you can view it again later and send the link to Grandma and Grandpa as well. To do this, we are asking you to email us one picture of your graduate. You can include their name as you would like it to appear, grade, and school (if desired). We understand some people may be concerned about having their child's picture and information available on the internet, so if you prefer not to participate, or to send us just some of their info, (ie, just a picture without a name, or just a name with no picture) we will only include what you send us. # News and Announcements

Dear Parishioners,

A letter to help update you on our parish financial health during the COVID-19 pandemic:



The requirement this past March to suspend the celebration of public Mass ushered in an unprecedented time for the Church, disrupting our routine of fellowship, worship, and holy communion. As we are seeing all around us, when routine is disrupted, there can be a domino effect, as is the case with the routine of regular offertory collections. We realize too, that some of you are experiencing the same loss of routine when it comes to your personal income!

Many of you have continued to send your regular offertory envelopes by mail, drop them off in the boxes at church, or you enrolled in Pushpay Online Giving! Your parish continues to be blessed by our long time, dedicated and consistent supporters. God bless you for your continued generosity, and to all who do whatever they can.

As a reminder, the majority of our income comes from offertory collections. The remainder comes from fundraisers and donations. When our 2020/21 budget was approved in February, no one foresaw the coming pandemic and its rippling effects. One of our largest fundraisers, the All Saints Church Festival is postponed (hopefully) to early fall. The Chris Kroeze Concert scheduled for June 20 must be moved back to summer of 2021, although we hope to have a virtual livestream concert on June 20 as sort of a “teaser” for next summer. In short, with the loss of opportunity to hold these important fundraisers, we are beginning to make some tough decisions for the operations of our parish and school.

We have taken a number of measures to cut expenses while the students are learning from home (i.e. school utilities of electricity and water, and the heat has been turned off. We have reduced trash disposal services for the school and put completely on hold for the church. With students studying at home, general supplies, toiletries and cleaning supplies have been adjusted accordingly.

The parish has also turned the heat to lower setpoints, made adjustments to maintenance hours and contracted lawn care. For the time being, services for printing the bulletin have been discontinued. The need for printed bulletins has dropped to a minimum and we're able to print the needed copies on the office printer. IT (computer) services for the parish are being reduced, although that's only temporary, as computers require ongoing service. With the guidance of the Finance Council, all school and parish staff salaries will be kept at their current salaries and will not receive an increase in the new fiscal year. Father David has made the decision to reduce his priest stipend by 50% for the month of May and for June if it's necessary.

With the loss of opportunity to fundraise, our overall parish income will depend on offertory collections, which depends on each of us; whether you would've dropped an envelope into the weekly collection basket or use online giving - it is important we continue to have a steady level of collections. Thinking and talking about finances can be unpleasant and make us uncomfortable, especially when family incomes may be suffering as well. God often uses challenging and uncomfortable situations among his people in order to strengthen their resolve, and make known his will for us. May this hold true for all the parishioners of All Saints Catholic Parish and School!

God bless all of you who continue to answer God's call to be part of our Catholic community as you participate in Holy Mass (even if it's LIVEstreamed at this time) and for your continuing support of All Saints as God enables you to. We hope the day we can be together to celebrate Mass publicly is in the near future. What a joyous day that will be! May it please God.



**New Mail Slot** - With the help of David Zietlow, we have installed a new mail slot located on the carport side of the church complex. We realize people have varying schedules and routines, so we hope this will accommodate our parishioners who wish to deliver something outside of parish office hours. For example, this mail slot can be used as a secure way to drop off your adult offertory envelopes, a document Father may be waiting for, or perhaps return a key in a marked envelope. (As much as Father enjoys chocolate chip cookies, the basket on the other side may not accommodate really heavy objects) - so what you slide through the slot should be rather lightweight in nature.


