PLEASE PARDON OUR DUST

Starting July 6th, there has been noticeable repair work taking place in front of the church. Over the past three years, we have been collaborating with our HVAC contractor about a damaging water leak in the basement that comes from the HVAC venting in the wall. After much discussion and research to determine where the water is coming from, we have reached the conclusion that we must repair and re-route some of the HVAC piping that is underground in the front of the building. The water that is coming through the venting pipes and draining back into the building which is causing condensation to build up in the pipes and flue gases are snuffing out the boiler, which over time will cause further issues. To prevent this, the repair is necessary and unavoidable for health and safety reasons. We have researched many options to make this as minor of a repair as possible and the option decided upon will only affect the outside of the building and nothing in the gathering space above will be affected.

Questions and Answers:

- **How long will the repair last?** With a start date of July 6th, the contractor estimates that we should have everything closed up and repaired within 2-3 weeks from the start date, provided we do not run into any obstructions in the plan to repair the HVAC vent pipes.
- **How much is this repair going to cost?** Unfortunately, the overall cost of the repair is estimated at \$66,000. The quote includes everything from start to finish with excavation of the site, contractor services to help put everything back in place, as well as the HVAC contractor to rebuild the venting pipes that go to the boilers. This includes supplies, materials, and labor. A factor contributing to the cost of the project is the increased price for quality stainless steel piping for HVAC venting. This expenditure will be capitalized and was approved by the Finance Council to proceed with the repair.

ATTENTION CONFIRMATION CLASS OF 2020





Our new photography safety protocols include:

SAFETY TRAINING

Lifetouch employees are required to complete comprehensive safety and cleaning protocol training.

PRE-SESSION HEALTH CHECK

Photographers are provided a thermometer for their daily self-health assessment before reporting to a photography event.

NO-CONTACT POSING & SOCIAL DISTANCING Photographers are required to maintain six feet between themselves and subjects while being photographed.

ENHANCED CLEANING

Photographers are provided sanitizing wipes and spray to clean camera stations and equipment.

MASKS

Photographers are required to wear masks during the entire photography session.

Please know that your information is safe, and Flocknote does not "own" your information. You can add yourselves to any groups and manage the messages you want to get from groups that you may participate in, such as the Usher Group or the Ministry Groups we will be building. You may also choose to "unsubscribe" at any time, although we hope you will want to stay connected with us to know everything going on in our parish community through newsletters, updates, and upcoming events.

You didn't get the email?? No worries! We are also in the process of updating our ParishSoft database along with our Parish Directory.
