WRTL is focusing a lot on polygon targeting to reach mothers in danger of aborting their children. Polygon targeting uses technology, through a mobile device's GPS system, to push out pop-up ads to just people in certain, precise locations. So a mother, even while sitting in the waiting room of a clinic and scrolling through her phone, will see pop-ups about alternatives to abortion. A reported 172,000 clicks per month by women who may be looking for alternatives.


