
All Saints Catholic School enrollment is open for 2020-2021! This includes enrollment for our 3K program.

Natural Family Planning – Respecting God's gifts of love and life



Want to learn?

Maybe you've heard the term Natural Family Planning before, or have seen its acronym, NFP, in church bulletins, or in brochures, but have never really understood exactly what it was, or why you should bother. Maybe you know what it is but think it's outdated, or that it doesn't really work. Maybe it's something you've been using for a long time, but things have changed, and you're not sure how to make it work anymore.

A brief explanation: NFP, or Natural Family Planning, is a way of utilizing scientifically based methods of postponing or achieving pregnancy without the use of contraceptive devices, chemicals, or medical procedures. A couple learns about their gift of fertility by learning about the physiology of the woman's natural cycle. In short, conceiving a baby is possible only during a certain window of time within her cycle. Using different charting methods to track fertility, a couple can decide to abstain during this time if they wish to avoid or postpone pregnancy. Conversely, they can decide when the ideal times would be to conceive a child as well.

There are many reasons to embrace Natural Family Planning. The Catholic Church teaches this is the only real ethical form of "birth control" because it is the only one that respects both aspects of God's gift of sexual intimacy: namely the gift of love and unity between husband and wife, along with the gift of life that can result from it. Unlike contraception or artificial means of birth control, NFP creates a new way of viewing intimacy. It demonstrates that together, a couple can say "no" and do no harm to God's gift of fertility, thereby making the times of "yes" that much more meaningful. They are giving each other, and God, the total and complete gift of self. Many couples found that using NFP helped build healthy and open communication, and a joint sense of responsibility for forming a family. Aside from religious or ethical reasons, there are also health benefits of not altering the body's natural chemistry by long term use of artificial hormones.

Unfortunately, we live in a world that portrays love and physical intimacy as self-satisfaction and pleasure. But that diminishes the language of true love, which, as the Lord himself taught us, is built on self-sacrifice. Using NFP can be a revolutionary tool in inviting true love - God's love, into a marriage on a more intimate level than you may have thought possible.

I'm sure by now you're totally convinced that this is something you have got to look into! Even if you're skeptical, please check out the many NFP classes that are available through the diocese:


