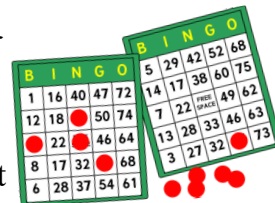

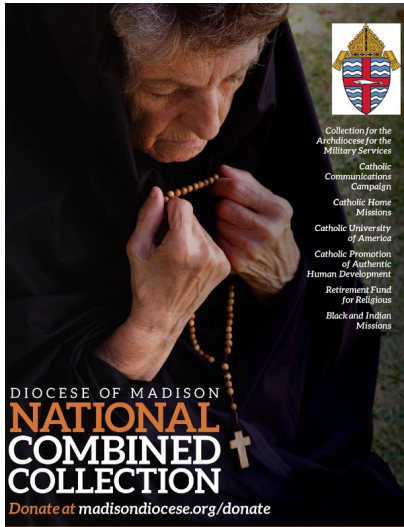

WELCOME BACK STUDENTS AND STAFF!

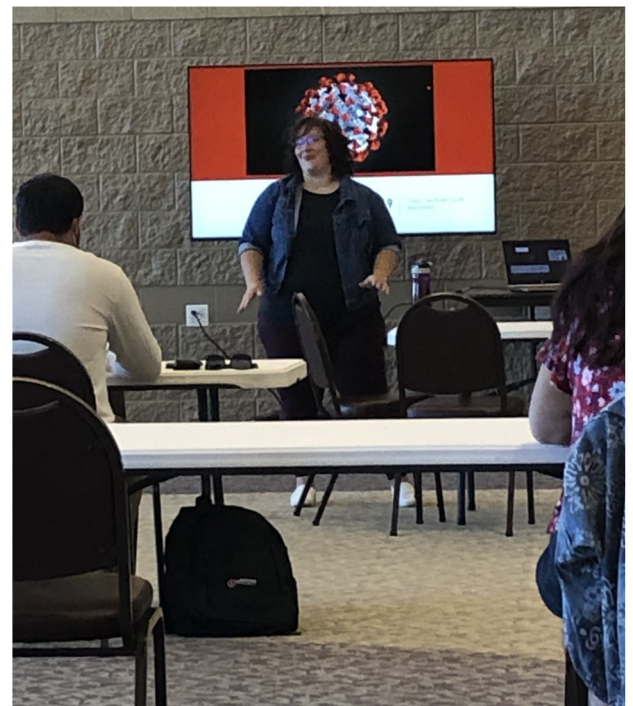
