### Looking Ahead.... To Christmas!



As we prepare for the Advent/Christmas Season, we need your help in gathering information regarding who will be attending Mass at All Saints Catholic Church for the celebration of The Nativity of our Lord on December 24th & December 25th.

We hope the COVID situation is much better by then, but we have no way of knowing that, so are approaching this as if we would still have a maximum capacity of 200 in the worship space. With that in mind, we are trying to determine whether adding an additional Mass will be necessary, and if so, what time would best accommodate people. We plan to have our usual Mass times as follows:

Thursday, December 24th ~ 4:30 PM Children's Mass and 7:30 PM Mass

Friday, December 25 ~ 10:00 AM Christmas Morning Mass

## Building Saints, Scholars, and Children of God

Something exciting is always happening at All Saints Catholic School!


Students recently attended a virtual field trip through the Horicon Marsh Education Center where they learned about Monarch butterflies. Though the students could not go in person, they were able to learn from Wildlife Conservation Educator Liz Herzmann, who shared information about the Monarch butterfly lifecycle, food sources, migrations, and how and why the Monarch butterflies are tagged. They also learned how to determine the gender of Monarchs while in the chrysalis and after emergence as an adult.



Then something extra special happened. Fifth grade student Marshall Hess brought in a Monarch caterpillar that he had found near his home. The middle school science classes were able to view the caterpillar, feed it milkweed, and witness the forming of the chrysalis. Then on Tuesday, September 22, the adult butterfly emerged. Using the information the students received during their virtual field trip, they were able to determine that their Monarch guest was a male. The school then obtained some butterfly tags from Ms. Herzmann, and the Monarch was tagged during Mrs. Cason's 5th grade science class on Wednesday, September 23. The butterfly was then released onto some flowers near the school, and the students wished him well on his journey. Incidentally, the students decided to name him Journey, and he was released to the music of the band, Journey.



What a wonderful opportunity for our All Saints Catholic School students to learn the lessons and then have the gift of experiencing the lifecycle of a Monarch and be part of the tagging process. God is always working in mysterious ways. How often we see that in our school and in our classes, and through the lenses of our student's eyes!

### Compassionate, gratuitous services available for divorced Catholics and those in irregular marriage situations

In an effort to improve our diocesan ministry to divorced Catholics and those in irregular marriage situations, our diocesan tribunal has expanded its services to include a Pre-Petition Case Advisor. A Pre-Petition Case Advisor accompanies an individual through the discernment process following a divorce by explaining the Church's teaching on marriage, making a personal assessment of any moral and canonical remedies available, and providing assistance in petitioning for a declaration of nullity (commonly referred to as an annulment).

Amy Klarkowski, previously the Moderator of the Tribunal Chancery for the Diocese of Madison from 2014-2019, has stepped into this role of Pre-Petition Case Advisor.
