

Our Online Basket Raffle Begins This Week!!

Each basket will have a set number of spots or "tickets" available to purchase. "Ticket(s)" can be purchased via a link to PayPal. The cost of each "ticket" will be dependent on what is in each basket. When buying your online "tickets" it will be important to leave a comment stating your name and how many tickets you want for each basket. Compassionate, gratuitous services available for divorced Catholics and those in irregular marriage situations

In an effort to improve our diocesan ministry to divorced Catholics and those in irregular marriage situations, our diocesan tribunal has expanded its services to include a Pre-Petition Case Advisor. A Pre-Petition Case Advisor accompanies an individual through the discernment process following a divorce by explaining the Church's teaching on marriage, making a personal assessment of any moral and canonical remedies available, and providing assistance in petitioning for a declaration of nullity (commonly referred to as an annulment).

Amy Klarkowski, previously the Moderator of the Tribunal Chancery for the Diocese of Madison from 2014-2019, has stepped into this role of Pre-Petition Case Advisor. If you or anyone you know has questions about marriage nullity or how to petition for a declaration of nullity, contact Ms. Klarkowski directly at (608) 821-3068 or send an email to amy.klarkowski@madisondiocese.org. The information you provide will be kept confidential and services are always at no cost to you.


