


**International Combined Collection**

#### What's Happening at our Catholic School

It's been eight weeks since All Saints Catholic School has started the school year and we just completed our first round of parent teacher conferences! They were not our traditional face to face conferences, but having the conferences virtually still allowed us to connect and communicate with parents to ensure we are all working together to help move each student forward academically as we help prepare them for the future.

The week was also busy as staff and students in second through eight grade were busy testing, doing the Star 360 Assessments in reading and math. The Star 360 Assessment reports help provide important data so that staff can drive instruction to an individualized curriculum for each student.

There are so many wonderful opportunities for students attending All Saints Catholic School and one thing the students are able to participate in, is becoming more fluent in Spanish. Children, starting in kindergarten partake in Spanish class, offered by Maricela Galindo. Children learn Spanish as well as learn about the culture which helps increase their awareness of the world! The students look forward to the weekly Spanish lessons and learning a new language, something we are happy to offer the students attending All Saints Catholic School. Younger students recently learned their colors in Spanish, while older students played a game of Spanish lightning using a basketball, and they prayed a decade of the Rosary in Spanish.

## Compassionate, gratuitous services available for divorced Catholics and those in irregular marriage situations

In an effort to improve our diocesan ministry to divorced Catholics and those in irregular marriage situations, our diocesan tribunal has expanded its services to include a Pre-Petition Case Advisor. A Pre-Petition Case Advisor accompanies an individual through the discernment process following a divorce by explaining the Church's teaching on marriage, making a personal assessment of any moral and canonical remedies available, and providing assistance in petitioning for a declaration of nullity (commonly referred to as an annulment).


