Starting this program, all of our students have the opportunity to enjoy a hot lunch without any extra cost to our families. Even better news came when we learned that the program is being back dated to November 1 and will go through the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year!

When we started the enrollment process for the free hot lunch program, we were not sure if we would be able meet all the requirements, but after persevering following through with all the paperwork, God once again provided for our students and families! 



CHRISTMAS MASS SIGN- UP


In light of COVID-19, this Advent and Christmas Season will present challenges when worshipping the Christ Child and celebrating His nativity. However, using the creativity God has given us, it also gives us the opportunity to do it in new and different ways! This year there will need to be a Christmas Mass Time Sign-Up to ensure we stay within our maximum capacity limits and prevent overcrowding (Our max capacity is 250 people which includes utilizing the gathering space with chairs set up; socially distanced.) We ask that parishioners only sign up for one Mass time to fulfill their Holy Day of obligation. Please include the number of people in your household and any out of town guests that may be accompanying you.

Below are the Signup Links for Christmas Mass Times. Each Mass time has its own sign up link. There will be only 200 spots available per Mass and will be first come first serve. If one Mass becomes full, we hope you will sign up for a different Mass time, even though you may not be the one you are used to attending. For those who do not have internet access to sign-up, we ask that family members assist each other in doing so, or you may call the parish to have a parish office team member assist you in signing up for a Mass time.

To sign up - go to the corresponding link for the Mass you wish to attend. Click on the orange box that says Sign UP, then select Submit & Sign UP. You will then be able to enter the family name and number of people who will be in your household attending that Mass.


