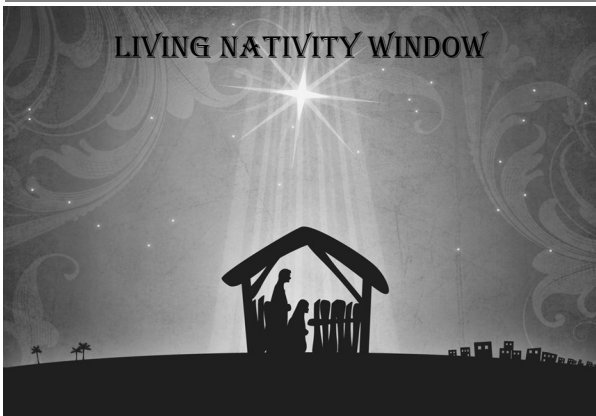

Building Saints, Scholars, and Children of God

What's Happening at All Saints Catholic School

Giving students the opportunity to learn hands-on and obtain valuable information is one of the greatest ways to learn. During the end of October, middle school students from All Saints Catholic School spend three fun-filled days learning about science and energy from Bill Harris of Renewable World Foundation.



Students in sixth, seventh and eighth grade enjoyed gathering at All Saints Catholic Parish where they could spread out, explore and learn. Held in the parish hall, Harris shared his passion and knowledge with the students, while providing them the introduction on the basic theories of electricity and Ohm's Law. Ohm's law states that the current through a conductor between two points is directly proportional to the voltage across the two points. These theories were presented using a number of hands-on activities, including a Jacob's ladder and a Tesla coil that demonstrated how electrical currents and charges are created, how electricity is conducted, and how electricity is transmitted. Harris used solar panels, wind turbines, and hydroelectric generators to help the students learn more about renewable energy sources. Students also generated their own electricity and cooked a lunch of hot dogs and ramen noodles by riding a bike that was connected to a generator. The generator was hooked to a battery bank that was linked to a hot plate on which the food was cooked. It stood a great opportunity for the kids to have these first hand experiences. Renewable World Foundation strives to offer programs that provide high quality educational opportunities. Working with schools across the Midwest, the foundation works to engage students with meaningful hands-on, minds-on activities.

CHRISTMAS MASS SIGN- UP

In light of COVID-19, this Advent and Christmas Season will present challenges when worshipping the Christ Child and celebrating His nativity. However, using the creativity God has given us, it also gives us the opportunity to do it in new and different ways! This year there will need to be a Christmas Mass Time Sign-Up to ensure we stay within our maximum capacity limits and prevent overcrowding (Our max capacity is 250 people which includes utilizing the gathering space with chairs set up; socially distanced.) We ask that parishioners only sign up for one Mass time to fulfill their Holy Day of obligation. Please include the number of people in your household and any out of town guests that may be accompanying you.

Below are the Signup Links for Christmas Mass Times. Each Mass time has its own sign up link. There will be only 200 spots available per Mass and will be first come first serve. If one Mass becomes full, we hope you will sign up for a different Mass time, even though you may not be the one you are used to attending. For those who do not have internet access to sign-up, we ask that family members assist each other in doing so, or you may call the parish to have a parish office team member assist you in signing up for a Mass time.

To sign up - go to the corresponding link for the Mass you wish to attend. Click on the orange box that says Sign UP, then select Submit & Sign UP. You will then be able to enter the family name and number of people who will be in your household attending that Mass.
