

Watch your Mailboxes - We will be sending out the annual fiscal report for the parish and school. This information is from our last fiscal year, which was July 1, 2019—June 30, 2020. We strive to be good stewards of the gifts we receive from the generosity of our members, guests, and community, and we want to be transparent about how we are using these gifts. We are choosing to mail paper copies to each household so that all members have an opportunity to review this important information, including those who do not have computers or internet, and those who are not coming to Mass or are not particularly active in parish life due to Covid-19 or other reasons.

ADVENT is Here - O Come, O Come, Emmanuel!

The Church begins a new liturgical year this weekend with the first weekend in Advent. Advent is a time of joyful anticipation and preparation for the birth of the Christ Child at Christmas. This time of year is typically filled with all kinds of Christmas preparations: baking, shopping, decorating, sending cards, etc. And all of these things are good. However, if we lose sight of Jesus in all these preparations, we kind of miss the point. This year, why not incorporate some faith-filled activities to keep our focus on the real reason for the season. Doing so will help our hearts, minds, and souls be ready to embrace Christ this Christmas and share His Love with those around us.

One idea is to have an empty manger in the house. Each time someone does a good deed, they can put a piece of straw in the manger. On Christmas Eve, the manger should be full of straw, ready for the Christ Child.

Another thing you can do is to have an advent wreath in the house and bless it. The advent wreath has 4 candles, 3 violet and 1 pink. Each evening at meal time light the appropriate number of candles. We light a new candle each week, until at last, all 4 candles are lit. (The pink one is lit on week 3.) Reflect on the coming of the Light of the World on Christmas as we see the increasing light from the candles. CHRISTMAS MASS SIGN- UP

With Covid-19 still in our midst, this Advent and Christmas Season will present challenges when worshipping the Christ Child and celebrating His nativity. However, using the creativity God has given us, it also gives us the opportunity to do it in new and different ways! This year there will need to be a Christmas Mass Time Sign-Up to ensure we stay within our maximum capacity limits and prevent overcrowding We ask that parishioners only sign up for one Mass time to fulfill their Holy Day of obligation. Please include the total number of people that will be with you.

Below are the Signup Links for Christmas Mass Times. Each Mass time has its own sign up link. There will be only 200 spots available per Mass and will be first come first serve. If one Mass becomes full, we hope you will sign up for a different Mass time, even though you may not be the one you are used to attending. For those who do not have internet access to sign-up, we ask that family members assist each other in doing so, or you may call the parish to have a parish office team member assist you in signing up for a Mass time.
