

### FAITH FORMATION

#### This weekend is Divine Mercy Sunday

This feast day is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of Easter, as decreed by St. John Paul II in 2000. The devotion to Divine Mercy started with a humble Polish nun, St. Faustina, in the 1930's. Jesus often spoke to her of His Divine Mercy. He instructed her to have an image painted, gave her the prayers which became the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, and revealed His desire that a feast day of Divine Mercy be observed. St. Faustina recorded her conversations with Jesus in a Diary, which can be read by anyone today. We have a few copies of her diary in our church library. We welcome anyone to check one out and read for yourselves of the unfathomable depths of Christ's Mercy, and His deepest desire to extend that mercy to you.

The image at the right is the image that Christ asked St. Faustina to have painted. It depicts Jesus with His right hand raised in blessing, and His left hand touching His Sacred Heart. From His heart, two rays of light shine forth—one red and one white to represent the blood and water which flowed from His side when it was pierced on the cross. Under the image are the words, "Jesus, I trust in you."

#### **CHRIS KROEZE CONCERT SET FOR JUNE 26**






