PARISH PRESS

Beginning the weekend of **May 1st & 2nd**, we will slowly transition back to some (not all) of the practices at Mass. Following are some initial changes:

- Parishioners will process up to the front to receive the Holy Eucharist as we did prior to COVID-19. Those unable to safely physically walk up to the front may remain standing in place in their pews and a Communion Minister will come to you as we have done in the past. As parishioners process up for Communion, we ask that you please continue to wear your mask and maintain social distance between you and the household/ family in front of you. Please bring your own small hand sanitizer with you if you feel the need to sanitize hands prior to processing forward. All these are based on communication with the Madison Diocese and local Board of Health. The Diocese also strongly recommends and encourages that (for now) we continue to receive Communion in the hand as opposed to on the tongue.
- We will transition back to having youth assist as altar servers. The parish office will be in contact with families to determine who is comfortable in participating.
- Father David will return to hearing Confessions <u>prior</u> to Mass **at 4:00 PM on Saturdays** and **9:30AM on Sundays**.
- Scrip will be brought back to the window in the gathering space. People must social distance and allow one person / family at the window at a time, when purchasing Scrip.

To help continue the decrease of COVID-19, the State of Wisconsin and CDC recommends that everyone continue to wear masks, especially in public places which would include church - and to maintain social distancing. Sometime in the future, we will transition back to seating parishioners in every pew - as opposed to every other, but not at this time. As guidelines and recommendations change according to the Diocese and the Green Lake County Board of Health, we will continue to provide communication in our bulletin prior to any upcoming changes, and do our best to keep everyone informed.
