
### What's Happening at All Saints Catholic School



#### Holy Hill Trip

On Friday, April 30th, the second, fifth, sixth, seventh, and eighth grades from All Saints Catholic School went on a field trip to Holy Hill National Shrine and Basilica. The students attended Mass, participated in praying the rosary, walked the long hilly path that has the Stations of the Cross, ate a picnic lunch, toured the grounds, and visited St. Therese Chapel. Seventh grade found the original wooden cross from 1863 and searched for their vocabulary words that had to do with the

religious site. Holy Hill National Shrine and Basilica is located in Hubertus, Wisconsin, and it draws pilgrims from all over the world. The teachers and students wanted to experience a holy pilgrimage, and it was a great day to do that. The students spent the day praying, exploring, and attending Mass.







**Lawnmower News**—Our Church will be looking to purchase or acquire a new or acquire a gently used lawn mower for the Church grounds. The lawnmowers we currently have are definitely showing their age and the mower deck is quite beaten up. After discussing with a group of the volunteers who mow during the summer, we would be interested in getting a 60" cut, Zero-Turn Lawn Mower. Please contact the parish office if you know someone who may be downsizing or has one that they would like to donate. We are planning to manage this season with the equipment we have (hopefully with no major breakdowns).



If we do not find a gently used one or have a generous donor by the end of this calendar year, we will need to put the purchase of a new mower in the Church's budget for next year. At this time, the estimated cost for a new mower is \$6,000 to \$10,000, depending on the brand and whether it is a residential or commercial grade mower.

**Basket Raffle -** With our Parish Festival in the park a "Go" this summer, we will once again be needing several nice baskets for our basket raffle. Anyone is welcome to put together a basket! Listed below are some ideas to get you started. Keep in mind, that as much as we appreciate a nice bottle of wine, we are not allowed to have any alcohol in the raffle baskets.
