Phased Relaxation of Covid Restrictions

What follows is a brief summary of the timeline of events leading to cessation of diocesan Covid Mass guidelines and a return to normalcy.

- Pentecost Sunday, May 22 & 23 Reinstitution of availability of Holy Water in fonts.
- Holy Trinity Sunday, May 29 & 30 Reinstitution of Sign of Peace. (People may choose a non-contact gesture if they are uncomfortable shaking hands, which applies not only now but anytime throughout the year. We must be understanding of one another in how people choose to greet)
- Corpus Christi Sunday, June 5 & 6 End of capacity limits in churches (unless local ordinances require it)
- 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time June 12 & 13 This will truly be a return to the ordinary with no further diocesan Covid related guidelines. Saturday, June 12 is the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, a fitting end to the Covid-19 restrictions!

Congregational singing may resume, ushers no longer need to wear gloves or masks, Eucharistic ministers no longer need to wear masks during distribution of Holy Communion. Parishes must continue to follow any <u>local</u> civil orders that could still be in place, and people are encouraged to continue to follow any CDC recommendations that would still be in place at this time.

We thank God that fewer people are getting sick, and that we are seeing a return to a normal routine. We ask for His continued healing presence in our lives, our country, and the whole world.
