**+ Decision Point 4.3 The Prayer Process**

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Thank God in personal dialogue of what grateful for today
2. \_\_\_\_\_ Past 24 hours when we were or were not best version of self
3. \_\_\_\_\_ moments. In 24 hours, one significant moment that God speaks to us.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ Ask God’s forgiveness for our wrongs
5. \_\_\_\_\_ How is God inviting us to change my life
6. \_\_\_\_\_ Intercession. pray for others
7. “Our Father” pray slowly, deliberately, think about words

**+Forms of Prayer.**

- Blessing & Adoration: an \_\_\_\_\_ between us & our creator. Awe in God’s presence
- Petition: \_\_\_\_\_ what we are and ask for God’s help as Children of God
- Intercession: for the interest of others just like in Bible as they asked Jesus
- Thanksgiving: Showing God \_\_\_\_\_. Should always begin prayer this way!!
- Praise: God is \_\_\_\_\_.
